Proposed Programme

Section One: Course Content

Leeds Metropolitan University proposes an eight-week programme in English Language Development for students from the Turkish Consortium

The proposal is for a programme which would be delivered to up to two groups. The maximum size for each group is twenty-three students.

160 hours of ESL instruction including:

- 40 hours Examining British Culture (Living in Britain)
- 120 hours English language development (Upper Intermediate level)

Students will typically receive twenty hours tuition per week

The course will include:

- Course materials
- Access to university facilities on and off-campus, including:
- 24 hour library access
- Technology Enhanced Learning online access to resources for learning
- Initial and final testing
- Certificate of Completion
- Group transfer to and from Leeds Bradford Airport on arrival and departure
- 'Homestay' accommodation with local families, half-board Mon Fri, packed lunch at weekends

Academic Content

British life and culture.

One hour per day (Monday to Friday) of input sessions. Students will gain a deeper understanding of British society through lectures and collaborative activities.

English Language Development

Three hours per day from Monday to Friday of classroom based sessions where students will develop their Reading, Writing, Listening and Speaking skills.

All our tutors are qualified to British Council TEFLQ standard and are experts in English language teaching. Classroom activities will involve reviewing English grammar and syntax and also vocabulary development. There will be a particular emphasis on developing learners' academic reading and writing skills.

The maximum group size is twenty-four students.

Fees per group

£30,000 per group of up to 24

This fee includes

- tuition
- a £100 food card
- a transport pass for the eight week period*

for all students on the course.

A group leader (one for all the groups) will have 'homestay' accommodation and airport transfer included in this fee. All other costs (transport in Leeds, food on campus etc) will be met by this individual.
